## featuring CAROL LEBEAUX, Silhouette Artist



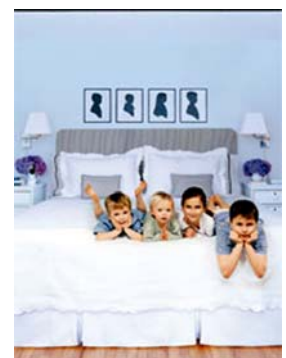

Influenced by the work of her great-grandfather, a portrait painter, she grew up admiring his renderings of their ancestors. Carol has a well-established reputation throughout New England, and is one of only a handful of true silhouette artists in the country. Her work has been featured in magazines such as *Vogue*, *Real Simple*, *Country Living*, and *House Beautiful*.
